Responsibilities and Duties

The Club Mentor should:

- Be responsible for driving a positive culture of the Eastern Suburbs Touch Association
- Be present at training and club events to provide support to players, officials, and parents
- Ensure that team, player and official's needs are being met
- Be a friendly and positive face for stakeholders of the club to idolise
- Attend

Knowledge and Skills Required

Ideally a Junior Representative Coordinator is someone who:

- Can communicate effectively and has good interpersonal skills
- Is positive and enthusiastic
- Is well organised
- Can delegate tasks to a support team

Time Commitment Required

The estimated time commitment required as the Junior Representative Coordinator of Eastern Suburbs Touch Association is 5 hours per week in peak periods September to March and 1 hour per week in off-peak periods.
